Assessment of Planet & Prosperity Metrics

During the April to June quarter Vertex commenced activities in relation to assessing our Planet and Prosperity Metrics, which includes disclosures for GHG (Greenhouse Gas) Emissions, TCFD (Task Force on Climate-Related Financial Disclosures) implementation, Water consumption, Economic contributions, Research & Development Expenses. The disclosures for both wealth and environmental metrics require internal organisational research and assessment which are ongoing activities that will help us develop meaningful disclosures, plans and actions. We aim to have the remaining disclosures completed before EOFY2024.
